

Syllabus for NTS Examination 2013-2014

The State level NTS Examination consists of 2 parts.

Part I is Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)

Part II is Mental Ability Test (MAT)

Part I - SAT

Part I [SAT] Examination consists of 90 objective type Questions in Eight Non language subjects namely History, Geography, Political Science, Economics, Physics, Chemistry , Biology and Mathematics.

Social Science	-	35 Marks
Science	-	35 Marks
Mathematics	-	<u>20 Marks</u>
Total	-	<u>90 Marks</u>

The Questions framed for SAT will be based on the syllabus for classes IX & X as prescribed by Kerala State Syllabus, CBSE and ICSE Board examinations for the current academic Year.

Part II -MAT

MAT Examination consists of 50 objective type questions for Mental Ability Test and 40 objective type questions for Language Comprehensive Test.

The Language Comprehensive Test will be conducted in English and in Malayalam. The Candidates have to attempt only one language i.e. either English or Malayalam.

The question will be available in 4 languages, English, Malayalam, Tamil, and Kannada except for Language Comprehensive Test.
